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ABOUT US

General practice is changing at a pace and we see this as a positive and opportunistic challenge. We are proud of the working environment we have created for our colleagues.

Our list is ~23,000 patients from a range of diverse socio-economic backgrounds. Our team serving this population includes a Nurse Practitioner partner, Managing Partner, 5 GP Partners, 6 salaried GPs, 2 salaried Nurse Practitioners (specialising in paediatrics, diabetes and medicine for older people). We have a skilled treatment room team with specialist interests including respiratory medicine, contraception, menopause and learning disabilities.

SystmOne is used for patient notes. This is shared across community healthcare teams throughout the city improving communication and patient safety.

We run a fully triaged acute service which is managed by a team of 'on the day' staff comprising a mixture of GPs, Nurse Practitioners and Physician Assistant.

HOW WE SUPPORT OUR PRACTITIONERS

At Lake Road we welcome the diverse skills and experience having a team of ANPs affords us. We have championed this by welcoming our lead practitioner to our partnership. She is an advocate for our allied health professionals with a clear insight into the challenges faced by our non-GP colleagues.

We encourage an open door approach to discussing cases and keeping in touch with the whole team. We have monthly in-house training and support sessions.

We are the lead Practice for the Island City network, providing us with a rapidly expanding support group of allied health professionals. At present this includes dedicated teams in Pharmacy, Social Prescribing, Physiotherapy and a Physician Assistant.

The Portsmouth Alliance has the 'Acute visiting service' and care home team reducing the need for urgent home visits.
